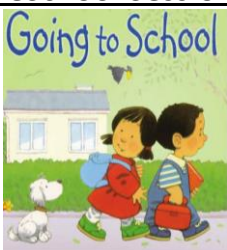


Playgroup Leavers Party Monday 22nd July
